# Daniels paces Seton; <sup>1994</sup> Columbia's Clark wins; East Side takes title

Sophomore Adam Daniels finished first in 17:13 to pace Seton Hall Prep, ranked No. 10 in The Star-Ledger Boys' Cross-Country Top 10, to the boys' crown in yesterday's Essex County cross-country championships at Branch Brook Park in Newark.

Senior Hazel Clark was the repeat winner in the girls' competition. Yanina Alvarez placed second to pace Newark East Side to the team title.

Seton Hall Prep, this year's Prep A Division champion, had all five of its runners place in the top 20, including a second-place finish for Jim Cacciabeve (17:33) and an eighth-place time of 18:02 for Brian Conway, to score 38 points and claim its first title since winning its third straight in 1991. Rui Nogueira was third in 17:37 to pace East Side, last year's champion, to a second-place score of 65.

East Side, second to Columbia last year, had all its five runners place in the top 20, including a ninth-place

finish by Ana Tavares (22:36) that helped East Side finish with 62 points.
